

## November 2021 Quarantine Report

### **GARBAGE DISPOSAL (SEAPORT)**

Thirty-two (32) requests for garbage discharge were received from vessels during the reporting period. The categories and quantities of waste that were approved for discharged are shown in the table below. In addition 9.8cm<sup>3</sup> of garbage was not approved for discharge, 47 metal drums were also not approved for discharge as well. For the reporting period plastics accounted for the largest quantity of waste discharged.
