REQUIREMENTS FOR LOST OR DESTROYED VESSEL CERTIFICATE

In the event of a lost or destroyed Certificate the following requirements are incorporated in the application for a new Certificate to be issued.

- 1. The full names, address and occupation of the owners of the vessel.
- 2. Where applicant is a representative of the registered owner, the capacity in which they are applying is to be stated e.g. personal representatives of the deceased or officials of a company. If they are representing a Company, they are to state expressly that they are authorized to make the declaration on behalf of the owner.
- 3. Description of the vessel in accordance with the Certificate.
- 4. State when, where and how the loss occurred, where the Certificate was kept, by whom and when and where it was last seen.
- 5. Indicate who had access to the Certificate if another party was holding it.
- 6. State what searches and enquires were made, by whom and with what result
- 7. State whether another party was holding the Certificate.
- 8. Undertaking to deliver up Certificate to Registrar General for cancellation if it is found
