  - Any other person specifically authorized in writing by the Owner. Where applicable a notarized Power of Attorney must be provided
- If the Applicant is a company, a Director or Secretary of the company should sign the application form. b)
- "Type of Ship" is as indicated on classification certificate. c)
- Indicate the ship's Official Number and IMO Identification Number. d)
- Indicate the ship's tonnage. The ship's tonnage shall be the gross tonnage calculated in accordance with the tonnage measurement regulations contained in e) Annex I of the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969.
- f) Indicate whether insurance contract, P & I cover, Bank Guarantee, etc. If security is finished in several forms, these should be enumerated.
- The period of validity of the security must be stated in terms of its exact dates of commencement and cessation and must coincide with the dates given in the g) insurer's or guarantor's etc certificate.
- Name (s) and address(es) of Insurer(s) and/or Guarantor(s) providing the security must be listed here. If the total amount of security has been furnished by h) more than the source, the amount of each of them should be indicated.
